




Who We Are







Some words on User Generated Content



What is UGC?

- also known as Consumer Generated Media (CGM) or User-Created Content (UCC)
- generally refers to various kinds of media content, made publicly available and produced by end-users
- can be text, photos, video and other material produced by endusers
- includes all digital media technologies (such as Q&A databases, digital video, blogging, podcasting, forums, review-sites, social networking, social media, mobile phone photography and wikis)
- partially or totally monitored by website administrators
- → best known examples: Flickr, YouTube, Europeana 1914-1918



How is UGC different from 'official' material?

- unknown or new content
- personal, not institutional
- not necessarily appropriate, useful or trustworthy
- diverse, exciting, different, strange



Some important aspects of UGC

- target purpose
- target audience
- target content
- level of entry and moderation
- → IPR (CC0 + CCbySA)
- keeping it alive



Why does Europeana want to collect UGC?

- to cultivate new ways for users to <u>participate & engage</u> in their cultural heritage in innovative ways
- to broker new relationship between curators, content and users
- to strengthen collaboration with the network and share knowledge (Europeana strategic plan 2011-2015)
- to promote end-user engagement
- to help enrich existing content and data (e.g. geo-tagging)


















Add your story


