HAZU in the project Europeana Cloud (eCloud)

- → Unlocking Europe's Research via the Cloud key objective: using the cloud technology for Europeana in order to collect metadata and digital content for the community of researchers
- → Since 1 February 2013
- \rightarrow Duration: 36 months
- → 33 participants
- \rightarrow Coordinated by the Europeana Foundation
- → CIP: Best practice network



The story begins with a letter of invitation...

by dr. Paul Ayris, president of LIBER:

"<u>LIBER invites members</u> to take part in a project proposal for the EU's PSP ICT Programme by submitting content to be aggregated by Europeana in a project proposal entitled Europeana Research."

"Data to be submitted could include full text of books, research datasets, OA journals, blogs and other academic content for which the Library has stewardship. Content from archives, museums, galleries and academic departments of interest to research libraries is strongly welcomed."

"The consortium must include content providers and can also include national or domain specific aggregators."



...and continues with application by DIZBI HAZU

HAZU as a content provider

<u>18 textual collections</u> (monographs, serials, cast sheets, Mss, typescripts, microfilms):

history, literature, philosophy, law, language, art, music, theatre, ethnology, social sciences, science, technology

estimated number of items: <u>13.911 (1650 vols</u>+ ca 9.000 articles) + Old and Rare Books (8)

The oldest item: 16th century

<u>11 artworks collections</u> (plaster casts, medals and plaques, copies of frescos and Croatian sculptures, photos, paintings, architectural drawings) estimated number of items: <u>871</u> The oldest item: 15th century



HAZU in eCloud

The main goal for HAZU: bringing new metadata (and content) from the repository of HAZU <u>dizbi.hazu.hr</u>

into the Europeana



DIZBI – questions about sustainability

 \rightarrow What at the end of eCloud?

How to digitise new content? (funding in 2014: 14.000 kn for digitizing obtained from the City of Zagreb and 20.000 kn for repository maintenance - from the Academy)

 \rightarrow How to increase the number of digitized items?

e.g. old and rare books (1550-1850) from 5 oldest libraries in Croatia digitized in last 10 years:477 (320 on the internet) and ca 160 old periodicals (19th-20th century)

→ How to make the administration i.e. the investors aware of the importance of digital libraries and digital content?

Our experiences since we joined the eCloud

- \rightarrow We have much work to do
- \rightarrow eCloud gives us:
- an opportunity to include Croatian cultural heritage and science into the Europeana
- an inspiration, a motivation to do more and more
- the opportunity to collaborate with colleagues in Europe
- confirmation, assurance that we are educated, familiar with digitizing, repositories, standards etc.
- and not less important: budget (in actual financial crisis)
- etc.
